

Burwell House is a residential centre just to the north-east of Cambridge, owned by Cambridgeshire County Council.

For 50 years, we have provided a fantastic venue for adult courses. We offer sole use of our 18th Century house, with a variety of rooms and workspaces and 3 acre garden. We can provide a fantastic fully catered service and all the help and advice you might need in providing a successful residential course.

The house

Downstairs there are a number of different sized rooms, which are suitable as meeting rooms, rehearsal rooms or other activity space. There are also a number of 'satellite' buildings, including our TV studio, a craft studio and a darkroom. The house is wifi enabled, and TV and DVD facilities are provided.



Sleeping accommodation

Upstairs the 11 bedrooms provide 60 beds in total, ranging from small 2 - 3 bedded rooms to larger dormitory rooms, with bunk beds. If groups do not wish to use any upper bunks there are 37 single beds and lower bunks in total. Tea / Coffee facilities can be provided in all rooms, and all rooms have toilet and shower facilities nearby.

On occasion groups have supplemented the sleeping facilities by having course participants camp or caravan in the garden. This can also sometimes be possible.



Outside

3 acres of landscaped gardens surround the property, containing much of interest, with a large orchard, a meadow area, a wildlife pond and many seating areas. There are various sculptures dotted around the garden which add to the ambience of the place.



Food

Adult groups are normally provided with a cooked breakfast, cooked 2 course lunch and cooked 2 course evening meal. This can be served canteen style, or more formally with table service. In addition groups are provided with refreshments, including

home-made cakes biscuits during each morning and afternoon. Most special diets can be catered for given sufficient notice.

Accessibility

Whilst the upstairs of the house is not easily accessible to wheelchair-bound course participants, we are easily able to convert one of our downstairs meeting rooms to a bedroom space and there is a fully accessible hygiene suite for these course members.

Location

Located 10 miles to the northeast of Cambridge, Burwell House is easily accessible, via the A14 and A11, from many parts of the country, and there is plenty of secure free parking on site. We are within 20 minutes drive of Newmarket

and Ely railway stations, and are directly on a bus route from Cambridge. The village of Burwell itself has a number of churches, small supermarket, chemist, pubs and gift shops, as well as a number of country walks. There are also a number of nearby visitor attractions, such as Anglesey Abbey, Wicken Fen and Cambridge itself.
