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What can I expect on a Burwell Outreach Evacuation Day?

Burwell Outreach trips are lead by our specialist, experienced staff, risk assessed and linked to the national curriculum. The Evacuation Experience aims to use role play to empathise with children evacuated from London in the 1940s, and to understand the feelings and experiences of evacuees.

- We can accommodate up to two classes per day, with a maximum of 34 pupils per class.
- The day runs between 9:30am-3:00pm.
- Coaches will now be required for the whole day as there will be a short journey from Nene Valley Railway to our new period classroom at Orton Mere.
